# **KEPHRA & GUS**

Gus was raised by our incomparable Rutgers University Companion Animal Club; riding campus buses, attending class, and living in the dorm.

Sweet, gentlemanly, tall Gus and Kephra immediately bonded when they met. Kephra suffered his injuries in a car accident. Gus retrieves dropped items, stabilizes Kephra during his blinding headaches (paws on Kephra's lap, even against his chest if he keeps leaning forward during an episode) and happily accompanies him. They go shopping, to the park, out into the world together.



Here's how Gus has changed Kephra's life, per Kephra's fiance, Jen. "Gus has given Kephra independence, safety, grounding, and help with emotion regulation. He's prevented major falls and injuries at least 6 times in the 5 months we've had him. By picking up things so Kephra doesn't have to bend over, Gus has prevented countless more falls. My anxiety as a caregiver has decreased knowing Gus is there to help. Kephra loves the routine of caring for Gus. He brushes Gus's coat daily, which they both enjoy. Having a pup who loves him has helped Kephra a lot!"

# **CHRIS & GERTIE**




When Chris and athletic Gertie met, they had an instant bond. Chris. a Veteran who was a Combat Medic and served 15 months in Iraq, was leading a lonely, isolated lift due to PTSD.

Now he has a purpose - caring for Gertie. Making her happy is making himself happier. This happy, high energy girl is up for a walk anytime! Chris now loves being outside with her and is happy to give her 7 mile walks/day.

They love their ball throwing sessions at a nearby park. He treasures her affectionate companionship. When he has a nightmare, she wakes him up by licking his face. He now has fewer panic attacks during the day. He's even felt moments of joy - when she went swimming and fetched the stick he threw her.

Animal Control picked up Hope, but her brother had already been killed by a car. We adopted Hope. Vittoria, a high school student with disabilities, raised her for us. Vittoria blossomed in confidence as she stepped up to raise Hope to be a Service Dog.

Now this sweet dog is Vittoria's service dog and constant companion. They passed the Public Access Test in August to become a service dog team. Very closely bonded, Hope follows Vittoria everywhere in the house, keeping a close eye on her.



Vittoria still drills Hope daily to enhance her service dog skills and is even teaching her to fetch her toys by name. Vittoria looks forward to attending college with Hope by her side.

David's wife describes them: "David has a routine now and a responsibility to the most adorable dog. Before, David wouldn't go out for days. Now he walks at least 4 miles a day! He recently attended a wedding with me. In the past he avoided crowds.

He'll even ride the subway now! He navigated easily through the crowds at DMV when he renewed his license. When David starts to spin, Gizmo will either nudge him with his nose, or lick his face to bring him out of it. Gizmo is always there when David needs him."











## **OLIVIA & ROLLO**

Rolo was donated to us by a Missouri Service Dog trainer after his placement fell apart. Our Head Trainer flew there, spent several days assessing Rolo and training with him. She flew back with him and Rolo aced his flight experience!

After nursing Rolo back to health and sharpening his training, we placed sweet Rolo with Olivia. Strong chemistry from the beginning, they're inseparable. This lonely little girl's life has changed, as has her whole family's because of Rolo.

## **LARRY & FOREST**



Ex-Marine Larry & Forest chose each other at their initial meeting. Since then, their bond has grown deep and trusting. Larry served in the Marine Corps Reserve from 1996–2000, re-enlisted after 9/11, and deployed twice to Iraq as an infantry rifleman.

On April 26, 2005, an IED blast killed a close friend and sent Larry to the hospital for nearly two weeks—yet he returned to finish the deployment for his squad. He was later awarded a Purple Heart for his sacrifice and service.

"My second deployment was really rough. We lost 48 Marines," he says. Coming home, he realized the hardest battles weren't behind him. "The hard part was coming home... I was lost."

Before Forest, Larry avoided crowds and noisy spaces, and mostly stayed home. Now he'll even go to the grocery store. Larry says "Things I hate to do, if I do it with Forest, I don't mind. Like the Supermarket or any place with a lot of people."

Larry describes his life with Forest: "He's someone I can always count on. I feel safer when he's with me. He gets me out more. He's helped my sleep schedule. He always has my back. It's like having my battle buddy again."






## What We Accomplished in FY2025:
